



Clinic Nurse – RN / LPN 40 Hours

- Provides ongoing teaching/counseling, including but not limited to: health status, immunizations, preventative health, etc.

Education Requirements

- Graduate of an accredited Practical Nursing Program/accredited School of Nursing.
- 2 years of professional nursing experience in family practice, pediatrics, and/or OB-GYN, preferred.
- REQUIRED: Licensed Practical Nurse license/ Indiana State Registered nurse License.

RNs are eligible to apply for loan reimbursement from NURSE Corps Loan Repayment Program through HRSA (Health Resources & Services Administration).
