Lactation Team Leader 40 Hours

What you will get to do:

- Coordinate work assignments and schedule Breastfeeding Peer Counselor staff.
- Support WIC / NHC prenatal and postpartum participants in an individual or group setting to assist them in their breastfeeding experience.
- Promote breastfeeding to prenatals and work with postpartum clients/patients experiencing difficulties with breastfeeding through classes, workshops, support groups, etc.
