## **Licensed Clinical Social Worker Full & Part time positions available**

Due to expansion, Neighborhood Health Clinics, Inc. is accepting applications for Licensed Clinical Social Workers to help meet the psychosocial needs of our patients. This position will report to the VP / Chief Operating Officer.

The Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) will address crisis situations as well as chronic conditions and provide assessments and development of an individualized treatment plan along with mental health counseling. The LCSW will help our patients improve their ability to function in their environment, handle relationships, and solve personal/family problems through education, development of problem solving skills, and therapeutic techniques.

The LCSW will be able to improve recognition, treatment, and management of psychosocial, behavioral, and developmental problems and conditions in the clinic population. They will diagnose and treat adjustment disorders, depression, anxiety, stress management, and behavioral issues. Issues such as substance abuse, chronic mental illness (schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, personality disorders) and acute suicidal or homicidal ideation would be referred to community specialists.

Full and Part time positions are available with their respective eligibility for benefits. A Master's Degree in Social Work is required. Candidates must possess an active license as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker in the State of Indiana. A minimum of 3 years' clinical experience is required.
